Although many consumers buy water heaters based on the size of the storage tank, the first-hour rating (FHR), provided on the Energy Guide label, is actually more important.

The rating is a measure of how much hot water the heater will deliver during a busy hour. A

> larger tank doesn't necessarily mean a higher FHR. Estimate your household's peakhour demand and look for a unit with

an FHR in that range.

Everything else being equal, select a water heater with the highest energy factor (EF), the measure of a water heater's efficiency.
