
SEEK OUT SAFETY THIS SUMMER

- 2) **Electricity** is dangerous. Stay away from equipment and fences marked with **DANGER** signs or **high voltage**.
- 3) Never put **metal** objects in electric **sockets**.
- 4) Do not overload a circuit, outlet or extension cord.
- 5) Do not use appliances with a frayed cord.
- 6) Use a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI) for electrical devices used outside to help prevent electric shock injuries.
- 7) Keep electrical devices at least 10 feet away from water sources, such as a swimming **pool** or **spa**.
- 8) Never handle **electrical** devices when you are wet or standing in **water**.
- 9) Keep **kites**, **ladders** and **hunting** equipment away from power lines.
- 10) Always report an outage.
