

Don't let power surges damage appliances

electronic equipment, such as computers, entertainment systems and garage door openers. The purchase can be added to your electric bill at zero interest. These devices are easy to install - just plug them in.

If any of your appliances are damaged by an electrical surge, the warranty on the surge protection device would pay to repair or replace them. And unlike an insurance policy, you would not have a deductible. Ripley Power and Light would also replace the damaged surge protector at no cost.
